Art and Nature Center

Location: 577 East Front St., Perrysburg, Ohio 43551

Mobility Accessibility

- Wheelchair accessible raised garden beds and hose reels
- Garden Scoot scooters available
- Ergonomic hand tools for gardening
- Welcome Center and Courtyard restroom have wide doors and accessible press pads for entry
- Accessible parking spaces
- Accessible paved pathways near Virginia’s House and through the Courtyard
- Accessible entrance to Virginia’s House from the back
- Seating throughout
- Accessible small stage for Music in the Garden performances
- Green Door Studio is an accessible classroom for art and gardening classes

Baseball Stadium

Location: 406 Washington St., Toledo, Ohio 43604

Mobility Accessibility

Transportation/Parking

- Two paratransit/bus stops directly in front of the Third Base Gate and the First Base Gate
- Van accessible and general accessible parking spaces are available within 200 feet of multiple gate entries
- There are two wheelchairs available for use within the stadium if needed

Restrooms

- Every restroom has at least one wheelchair accessible stall with approximately 3-5 feet of turning space
- Accessible family restrooms are available
- Sink, soap and paper towel dispensers are at a wheelchair accessible height
- Accessible water fountains throughout the stadium
- Manual universal changing table with a garbage bin large enough for disposal of adult diapers

Entry

- Every entry point is a large gate and very wide for wheelchair access
- Entries are step-free and smooth thresholds
- Level surfaces outside of the stadium and thresholds within the stadium
- Accessible elevators for access to all levels

Seating

- Accessible seating throughout the stadium with unobstructed views
- Entries with steps have ramps available at a 1:12 ratio
- There is seating located together for individuals and companions

Visual Accessibility

- Braille available on signs
- Appropriate lighting and color contrast is available
- Line of sight sign language interpreters are available; must contact the ADA coordinator at least three days prior to attendance
- Emergency alarms make loud sounds

Hearing/Communication Accessibility

- Assistive listening devices are available for use with a valid driver's license or state issued ID
- Closed captioning on audio materials is available
- Alternative communication is available via notepads or writing and translator apps
- TeleTYpewriter (TTY) available by calling the box office and video relay service available where compatible.

- Emergency alarms have flashing lights

Cognitive/Sensory Accessibility

- Appropriate signs are located throughout the stadium
- Layout is predictable and consistent
- Items are clearly priced
- Disposable earplugs/noise-reducing headphones are available for use

Additional Accessibility

- Entry with reasonable amounts of food is allowed if on a special diet that the stadium cannot provide

Visitor Center, Museum, and Exhibits

Location: 29100 W River Rd., Perrysburg, Ohio 43551

Mobility Accessibility

Parking/Transportation

- Accessible parking spots are available at the front of the Ohio History Center

Entry

- There are free wheelchairs, including one motorized one, available to visitors on a first-come, first-served basis
- Each building is wheelchair accessible, but assistance may be needed over thresholds; staff members are willing and able to assist
- A paved path is available for use
- Accessible elevator for access to all levels

Restrooms

- Arrangements can be made for dinners or other public programs in the Ohio Village
- The front doors are located on the lower level with a sloped sidewalk leading into the building
- There are accessible restrooms available

 - Sensory bags include a special KultureCity VIP badge, feeling thermometer, fidget tools, and noise-cancelling headphones, and a weighted lap pad
- Quiet areas are available
- Headphone zones or loud areas are marked with signs
- By downloading the KultureCity App there is a social story available for the Ohio History Center and Ohio Village

Transportation/Parking

- There are 4 van-accessible or general accessible parking spaces available at the front entrance
- Vistula Parking Garage is available for additional accessible parking and there is an underground concourse that leads to the entry
- Wheelchairs are available and free to use during visits to the museum

 - Reservations can be made up to 7 days in advance
- TARTA Flex
 - On-demand curb-to-curb service that connect suburban and rural area
 - Pay with the EZfare app or exact cash and you can transfer to TARTA's fixed-route service for free
 - Reserve a trip in as little as 30 minutes before departure and as far ahead as the day before; be mindful of busy times
 - TARTA Flex drivers are not trained to assist passengers to the curb
